This programme, leading to registration as a midwife, is offered to nurses who are currently registered on the General Division of the Register of Nurses (or those eligible for registration) held by The Nursing and Midwifery Board of Ireland (NMBI), who are selected subject to interview and accepted by University College Dublin, the Hospital's academic partner.

A minimum of six months recent nursing experience in an **acute** care setting is required at time of application.

Midwifery students are paid a salary based on their appropriate incremental point whilst undertaking this 18 month Higher Diploma course.
