

Free Medical Health Care Information



If you are coming to live in Ireland or returning here to live, you must satisfy the Hospital that you are a Resident

To qualify for free medical health care, you must produce proof of one of the following at or before your first antenatal appointment:

- Proof that you have been Ordinarily Resident in Ireland for the last year OR Intend to Reside in Ireland for one year
- A letter or statement from a financial institution (for example bank statement, credit union statement)
- A current utility bill (such as gas, electricity or phone bill)
- current care or home insurance policy in your name
- A letter from Employer, contract of employment
- Medical Card Holder, number and expiry date.
- A Valid Student Card with Visa and letter from attending College.

If you do not have either of these documents you are required to pay a **Non-Refundable Fee** of €2,000 to cover your Maternity Care on your first visit to the Hospital.

Please be aware that failure to produce any of these documents will result in you being charged the fees below for your care and all bills must be paid in full when leaving the hospital.

Charges from 1st January 2023

- Non Refundable Booking Deposit of €2,000 (Public, Semi-private and Private)
- Public Ward per Night €1300.00
- Semi-Private Ward per Night €1600.00 (Plus Medical Fees)
- Private room per Night €1800.00 (Plus Medical Fees)
